TOUR HIGHLIGHTS:

STATE HERITAGE MUSEUM

Russia's best gallery of world art, one of the most prominent art museums in the world.

CATHERINE'S PALACE

Here the world famous Amber room is open to public.

NOVGOROD SIGHTSEEING TOUR

During this excursion you will explore the main historical ensemble of the city the Novgorod Kremlin, on which territory the symbol of the city St. Sophia Cathedral is located, and famous Yaroslav Courtyard.

"VITOSLAVLITSY"

Architectural and natural museum representing different types of wooden churches and Russian houses "Izba" in original design with dozens of artifacts, including furniture. They give the visitor a good idea about traditions of different parts of ancient Novgorod region.
